- **Policy roundtables and global case studies**

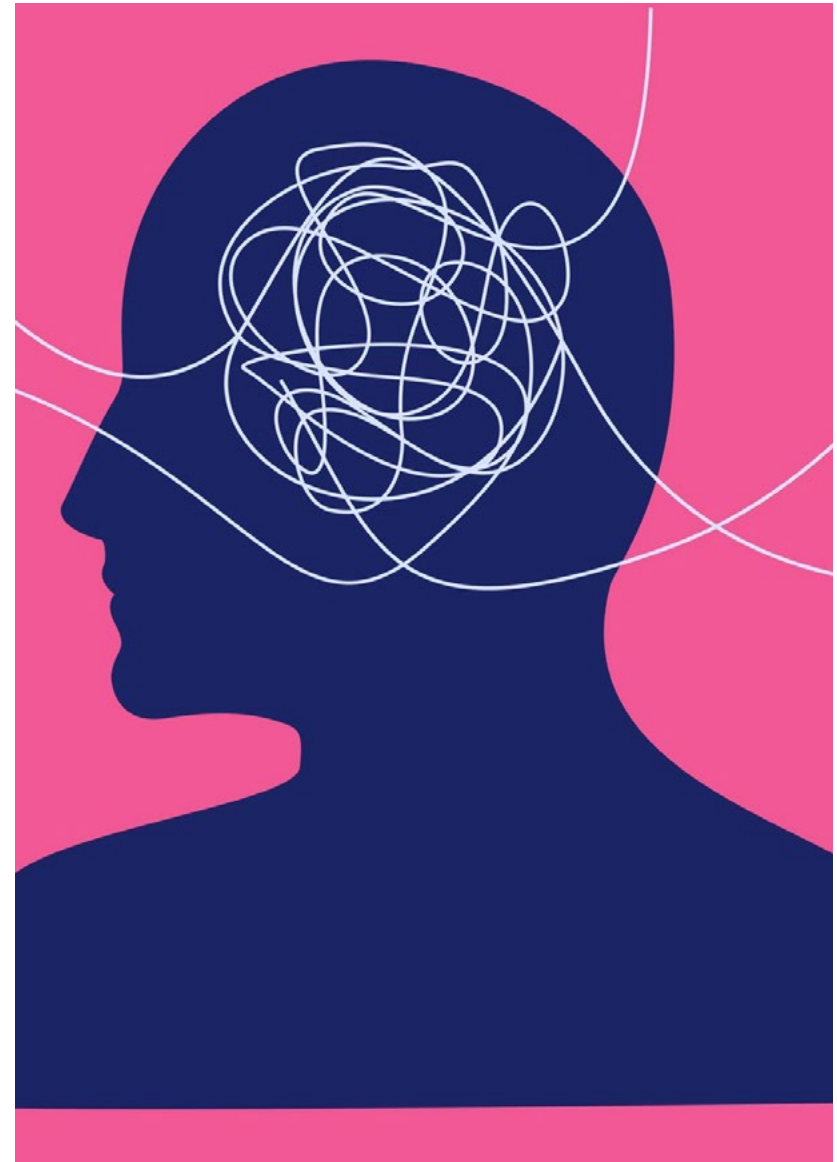
